Q: What is the most interesting place you have ever visited?

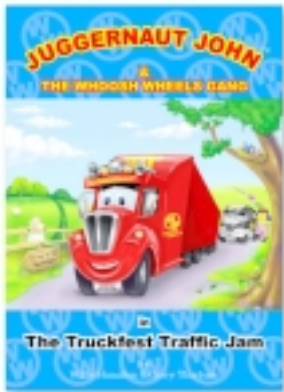
A: I like Edinburgh and York.
