A: Skellig by David Almond

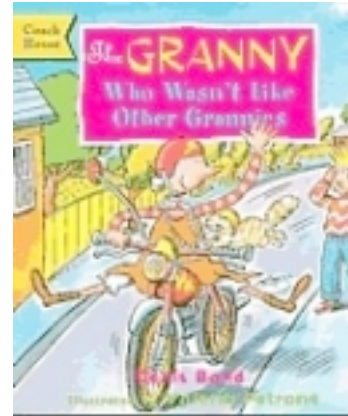

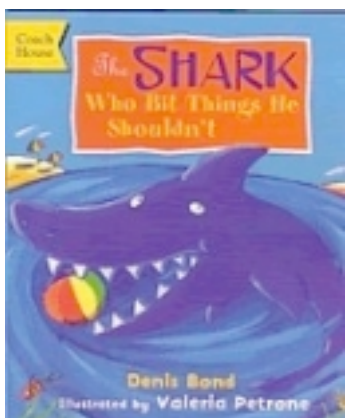

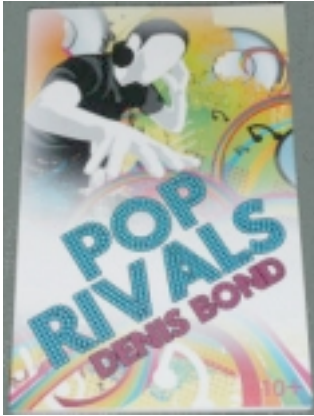
